Finally, you will train in all aspects of concrete batching and production. On successful completion of the Cadetship you will be placed at Higgins Concrete.

Driver Academy

- This 7-month programme supports you to achieve both your Class 2 and Class 4 heavy truck licences. You will also have a chance to gain additional endorsements and develop a strong understanding of Health & Safety in the workplace.

Year 2 (concrete technician focus)
 - On-job training in all aspects of concrete testing
 - Start BCITO National Certificate in Concrete Production (L3)
3- and 6-month assessments of development (more if required)
 If passed – Graduation certificate + pay increase

Year 3 (concrete batcher focus)
 - On-job training in all aspects of concrete batching & production
 - Continue & complete BCITO course
3- and 6-month assessments of development (more if required)
 On successful completion of assessments & BCITO course – Graduation certificate & cadetship completed, placement at Higgins Concrete, additional 12-month commitment of employment

Development

(12-week programme)

Week 1

- Induction (site and truck), PPE issued
 - Time in the truck observing, progress to starting to drive concrete truck, then becoming comfortable to drive empty truck
 - Time in truck observing truck being loaded for concrete delivery, then practice driving truck under plant and being loaded under guidance
- Competency assessment 1*

Weeks 2/3

- Assigned a buddy, taught day-to-day operations/responsibilities
- Move to driving and operating concrete truck under supervision of buddy, then becoming competent solo

Week 4

Competency assessment 2
If passed – wage rate increased

Weeks 5-8

- 4 weeks solo delivering concrete to site as required
- Competency assessment 3*

Weeks 9-12

- 4 weeks solo delivering concrete to site as required
- Additional full induction to Health & Safety, site hazards, golden rules

Final Competency assessment

If passed – wage rate increased (backpaid to date)
Trainee passed assessment 3 – paid in 2 lump sums)
